### CCC welcomes new Deputy Commissioner

Supreme Court Judge the Hon. Justice Stephen Hall has been appointed as the new Deputy Commissioner of the Corruption and Crime Commission, commencing 1 July 2026. Justice Hall will resign as a judge on 30 June 2026 to take up this appointment.

Mr Hall's appointment comes after the previous Deputy Commissioner, the Hon. Michael Corboy SC, was appointed as Commissioner in November 2025.

Mr Hall has served as a Supreme Court Judge for 17 years, for the last four of which he has been a judge of the Court of Appeal.

With a distinguished legal career spanning four decades, Mr Hall brings vast expertise to the Commission from criminal, administrative, insolvency and company law, to disciplinary tribunals and coronial inquests. He led complex cases for the Office of the Commonwealth Director of Public Prosecutions, including the largest fraud case in Australian history at the time, appeared as Counsel Assisting in the Finance Brokers Royal Commission in 2001 and the Police Royal Commission in 2002 to 2003, and was the presiding judge in a number of high-profile cases including the Claremont serial killings and the Motorplex Sniper. He also previously acted as Counsel Assisting the Corruption and Crime Commission in a number of matters.

Commissioner Corboy congratulated Mr Hall and welcomed his appointment as Deputy Commissioner.

"Mr Hall is highly respected as a judge, lawyer and prosecutor. His exceptional record, reputation and knowledge will be an asset to the Commission as we work to strengthen the integrity of the public sector, reduce corruption and disrupt criminal activity in Western Australia," Commissioner Corboy said.
